Informational on New Septic Loan Program

At the April 2016 Town Meeting, Manchester voters approved the Town's participation in the State Septic Loan Program. Manchester will now be able to accept applications to provide betterment loans to assist homeowners who must address septic system failures. Residents will be able to apply to the Town of Manchester for loan funds to either: repair or replace a failed septic system by renovating the existing system; hooking up to existing sewer; or replacing a traditional septic system with an alternative system approved pursuant to Title 5. Those loans will then be paid back by the homeowner as a betterment on their real estate tax bill.
