

Winter Parking Information

Street parking is allowed overnight during the winter months, unless a snow emergency has been declared, as indicated by turning on the blue lights at five specific locations around Town.

When the Chief of Police declares a snow emergency, the blue lights will be turned on, indicating the on-street overnight Parking ban is in effect. The Snow Emergency will be posted on the Town & Police Department Websites and all Social medial platforms. The lights will remain on as long as the snow Emergency and the on-street parking ban are in effect. The ban also includes sidewalks, so vehicles that attempt to get off the street by pulling onto the sidewalk will also be ticketed and towed.

Violations of the on- street parking ban are punishable by and a fine of \$50.00 and all vehicles are subject to being towed at the owner's expense.

The blue lights are in the following locations

- 1. Intersection of Central and School Streets, on a light pole.
- 2. Intersection of Summer at Forest Streets, on a light pole by the pickleball courts.
- 3. Intersection of Summer at Lincoln Streets, on a light pole.
- 4. Intersection of Pine and Pleasant Streets, on a electrical pole by Pleasant Grove Cemetery.
- 5. Intersection of School and Pleasant Streets, on an electrical pole closest to Old Rosedale Cemetery.
- 6. Intersection of Bridge and Harbor Streets, on a light pole near Winthrop Field.
