## **TRANSFER STATION & CURBSIDE RULES**

## **CURBSIDE:**

**Large item** – To arrange a large item curbside pick-up, resident must pre-schedule with JRM by calling: 800-323-4285. Pre-payment via credit card is required. Multiple items per week allowed. Place pre-scheduled large item(s) alongside your orange-bagged trash and recyclables, curbside by 7am on your morning of collection.

**Large items include**: household furniture (made of wood and/or fabric e.g. armchair, drawers etc.), rugs (folded and cut into 3 ft sections), mattresses, box-springs (multiple items per week allowed), and **rigid plastic items that are too large to entirely fit into an orange bag.** <u>NO</u>; metal items, electronics, large appliances, appliances with refrigerants (including AC's and dehumidifiers) allowed curbside – these go to the Transfer Station, please see below.

**Construction and wood waste** – only an amount that can be entirely contained within (and not sticking out of) an orange bag - <u>**CURBSIDE-ONLY**</u>. Items that come from house renovations such as windows and doors will require private disposal methods (see options below or <u>www.thebagster.com</u> for construction waste).

## **TRANSFER STATION**

RIGID PLASTICS ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLE (SEE WEBSITE FOR MORE DETAILS): <u>http://www.manchester.ma.us/223/Public-Works</u> and must be disposed of as trash entirely contained within an orange bag curbside OR if too large, by pre-scheduling and prepayment directly with Waste Management 800-972-4545.

All trash MUST be contained within an orange bag (unless on a ONE-TRIP pass)

**METAL** items - \$10 white sticker per item (household items that are 70% or more of metal) <u>unless on a ONE-TRIP</u> pass.

One-Trip Pass – designed for multiple metal items and/or trash not in orange bags: (\*)Refrigerant items (\$20 sticker), TV's: \$15 (under 27") & \$20 (over 27") stickers, computer monitors & laptops: \$10 sticker – stickers are ALWAYS required for these items even if arriving on a ONE-TRIP pass.

Recyclable items are unlimited quantity. Please refresh yourself on acceptable and unacceptable items to ensure our recycle stream stays on track.

<u>NO</u> CONSTRUCTION and/or WOOD WASTE at the transfer station AT ALL. See above. Auto tires are not allowed curbside or at the transfer station AT ALL – these require private disposal: suggested local options:

**North Shore Steel**, 11 Pond Rd, Gloucester, MA 01930. Tires accepted if still on rims, no charge – call 978-815-1893.

**Essex County Recycling Center**, 24 Kondelin Rd, Gloucester, MA 01930. Accepts auto/truck tires, and <u>construction</u> <u>waste</u>. Call 978-283-3335 for prices and details.

**G-Mello**, 203 East main Street, Route 133, Georgetown, Ma 01833. Accepts construction waste, furniture, appliances etc. Call 978-352-8581.
