I am forwarding the attached email secured via a PRR to the EOHLC.

Email dated September 14, 2023 from Nathan Carlucci, EOHLC, to MBTS representatives:

*"The FY2024 budget includes the language: 'provided further, **that housing authorities and nonprofit organizations situated in municipalities that do not comply with the provisions of section 3A of chapter 40A of the General Laws shall continue to qualify for funding from the local capital projects fund**'. This is a **change from last year**...."*

I presume that Greg's analysis ref this grant funding was adjusted in light of this recent advisory. Please post the MBTA Zoning grant analysis to the Town Website, if not already done.
