Hello Ms Mellish.

Please help me understand. At the October 16, 2023 meeting of the MBTA Zoning Task Force, Mr Olney remarked to the MIT study group in words to the effect that the LCD may be considered as part of the MBTA Zoning for the purpose of creating housing for CST employees. (Please correct me if I am inaccurate.)

QUESTION: Has the matter or a actual proposal to consider the current LCD for residential housing in the absence of an overlay been raised at any open public meeting before the ZBA, PB, or SB either orally or in any written document, or in any group outside OML constraints, including with our Town governance, to the best of your knowledge?

My concern here is that it is a commercial district presently. Even with an overlay, if any type of housing is to be considered we will need the scale, design, impact and peer reviews equal to what is currently going on across the street with the SLV project. My understanding is that CST will employ 500 employees. We certainly don't want to jeopardize the SLV case.
