Please secure the responses to the questions I posed below for INNES, as a courtesy and in the interest of open communication, public input, and in light of recent challenge by Milton MA residents based on election results. I am interested in getting to the foundational requirements for MBTS.

If I have missed your posing of the questions to INNES, please direct me to the meeting date and the Board where this data is available. I had requested baseline data last year per my emails.

Given the complexity of this challenge, the environmental and Ch 91 challenges and the fact that we are close in the General District per a recent email from Mr Olney to me attached below, the data will be key. I am recommending a negotiations with the EOHLC as a start to officially snapshot what we have and what we can do without adverse affects to our small Town of 9 sq miles of land mass.

Please also secure an official position from our ConCom with regard to the Gordon College parcel in MBTS near our watershed. I have not received a response from Mr. Gang to an email requesting the ConCom stance. Let me reiterate...our watershed is paramount to this community and Coastal Resiliency is our major challenge.
