Geothermal Wells

- Test for the BASIC 4 within 6 months of July 1, 2024
- Complete the BASIC 4 each year
- Test for the BASIC 4 within one year of July 1, 2024
- Complete the BASIC 4 on a 5-year cycle
- Complete BASELINE testing at time of construction
- Complete the BASIC 4 every year
- Complete BASELINE testing is required every 10 years
- Complete BASELINE testing at construction
- Complete the BASIC 4 on a 5-year cycle
- At the time of sale, and not more than
 1 year prior to transfer of the property.
- Up to one year prior to the Title 5 Inspection.
- Complete Baseline Testing.
- within 60 days after July 1, 2024;
- Current year's testing provided to the renter before tenacy begins.
- Complete Baseline Testing
- Open and split loop geothermal wells are required to meet the same
- conditions as new drinking water wells.

VOCs PFAS

(Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) including the following six PFAS chemicals (PFAS6):

- perfluorooctane sulfonic acid (PFOS)
- perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA)
- perfluorohexane sulfonic acid (PFHxS)
- perfluorononanoic acid (PFNA)
- perfluoroheptanoic acid (PFpA)
- perfluorodecanoic acid (PFDA)

Wells drilled into bedrock a Gross Alpha Screen and Radon test are required.

*The Board of Health recommends full comprehensive testing be conducted for the owner's knowledge and to assist in data collection efforts.
